## EXHIBITION RULES

Entries will only be accepted from anyone over the age of 55.

All exhibits must have been made by the person named on the Exhibit Label and must have been completed during the twelve months prior to the exhibition.

Exhibitors may, if they wish, incorporate this year's exhibition theme "Carnival" in their entry. However, this is not a requirement for entry.

No one may enter more than one exhibit in each class.

## HOW TO ENTER

- 1) An Exhibit Label (available free from Plymouth Age Concern centres) must be completed and securely attached to each item being entered into the exhibition, and must specify if it is an 'individual' entry or a 'club/group/centre' entry.
- 2) Clubs, groups and centres are required to complete a "Club/Group/Centre Entry Form" (available on request tel. 256020) and return it to the Exhibition Organiser by 1<sup>st</sup> June 2010 in order to help minimise delays on registration day. Note: Entry forms are not required for "Individual" entries, details of which will be taken at the time of registration.
- 3) **Exhibits must be brought to Elspeth Sitters House for registration on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2010 between 10.00am and 12.30pm.**
- 4) An entry fee of **50p per exhibit** will be payable at the time of registration.
- 5) Clubs, groups and centres must arrange for someone to display their exhibits on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> June from 1.30pm to 4.30pm.
- 6) In the interest of security, clubs, groups, and centres should arrange for a steward to be in attendance during opening hours of the exhibition (Wed. 16<sup>th</sup> – Sat. 19<sup>th</sup> June).
- 7) Best in Class, Gold, Silver and Bronze, Special Merit and Highly Commended certificates will be awarded at the discretion of the judges, whose decision is final. Cup winners are invited to a presentation of awards being held at 10.30am on Monday 21st June 2010 at Elspeth Sitters House. *Last year's winners are asked to return cups/trophies by the beginning of May.*
- 8) Exhibits are to be collected from the exhibition 11.30am – 12.30pm on Mon 21<sup>st</sup> June.
- 9) All items entered in the exhibition are displayed at the owner's risk; Plymouth Age Concern cannot accept responsibility for the loss or damage of these or other personal property brought to the exhibition.
